I am a registered voter, own my home in Frazier Park and consider myself to be an honest and upstanding citizen. I am extremely passionate about politics, justice and am well informed about events taking place within our country, our society and this community. I am 100% committed to the best interest of the Frazier Park community and believe I would be a valuable asset FPPUD, as well as the community. I would make it a priority to encourage and engage Frazier Park residents to attend meetings and take vested interest in events taking place within our water company and the community itself. I find it absolutely tragic that the community has shown little or no interest in attending meetings and expressing their concerns to the board. As you are well aware, the community is complaining about problems and issues regarding the water situation. Rightfully so, many community members have stated that they feel their voices aren't heard and have given up that anything will change. That said, it is critical that I reiterate a former FPPUD employee threatened me, "All it takes is 2 people to call the Sheriff and they will take you away", if attend any FPPUD meetings. I have a witness to this account. This is the exact reason I have not attended meetings for the past 2 years. Despite threats, I have decided to exercise my legal and civil rights and I fully intend to continue attending FPPUD board meetings.

I was extremely disheartened to see only 2 members of the entire community at the last 2 board meetings I attended. I highly recommend that the Mountain Enterprise promote water board meetings and stress the importance of community involvement. Unfortunately, last week The Mountain Enterprise erroneously listed regular meetings as being held the 3rd Thursday of every month. The regular meetings take place on the 2nd Thursday of every month. The Mountain Enterprise should also promote attendance of FPPUD meetings held 4th Thursday of every month regarding LOW annexation. It would also be helpful if The Mountain Enterprise would list the monthly meetings in the calendar section. Why has this not been done? As much as I understand and empathize with the dire situation in Lake of the Woods, I feel it would be irresponsible to annex until the issues with FPPUD are fully resolved.

In closing, I respectfully request to be the chosen candidate filling the vacated position previously held by Frank Durso. I will separately address issues and comments that took place at the October 13th board meeting in hopes of dissolving any misunderstandings concerning certain issues.


