Green Dragon Farms Community Scholarship

### **Overview**

Green Dragon Farms offers scholarship opportunities to students and community members residing in the Frazier Mountain communities. The goal is to build community leadership, foster healthy food choices, and encourage students and community members to reach academic and life goals.

Full scholarship, up to \$500, is based on 50 hours hands-on educational service experience with Green Dragon Farms. Service may include working with seeds, propagation, construction, irrigation, marketing and distribution. Educational involvement towards each benchmark is 10 hours service in a single month to receive \$100 stipend check. Total scholarship stipend award is \$500 and will include a achievement award and recommendation letter of completion. The total number of student scholarship awarded will be dependent on additional grant funds.

### **Educational Community Scholarship Criteria**

Award selection is based on interest in gaining leadership skills, community development experience, and to learn organic seed to table food justice.

Applicants must reside within the Greater Frazier Mountain Communities.
